

Start your dinosaur adventure

The missing dinosaur egg

Get ready

Print the nine child pages single-sided. Cut out the five eggs and station signs. Have crayons ready. The adult host keeps the eggs, story and answers. Children do not need to read.

The story

Oh no! One dinosaur egg has gone missing! The other four eggs rolled after it. Ferns rustle and enormous tracks cross the mud. Collect the four eggs along the way. Could the last one already be waiting at the nest? Let the search begin!

Indoors

Choose five easy-to-reach places in a safe play area. Put stations 1 to 5 in order. After each task, point to the next place or walk there together. No particular furniture is required.

Outdoors

Choose five nearby places in an easy-to-supervise area. Secure the pages against wind. The adult stays with the group and guides it to the next place. No climbing or water locations are part of the hunt.

Play together

Read each task aloud and point to the pictures. Helping, solving together and skipping a task are welcome. Give one egg after each of stations 1 to 4. At station 5, give the fifth egg first, then place all eggs in the nest and give out the certificate.



Answers, if you need them

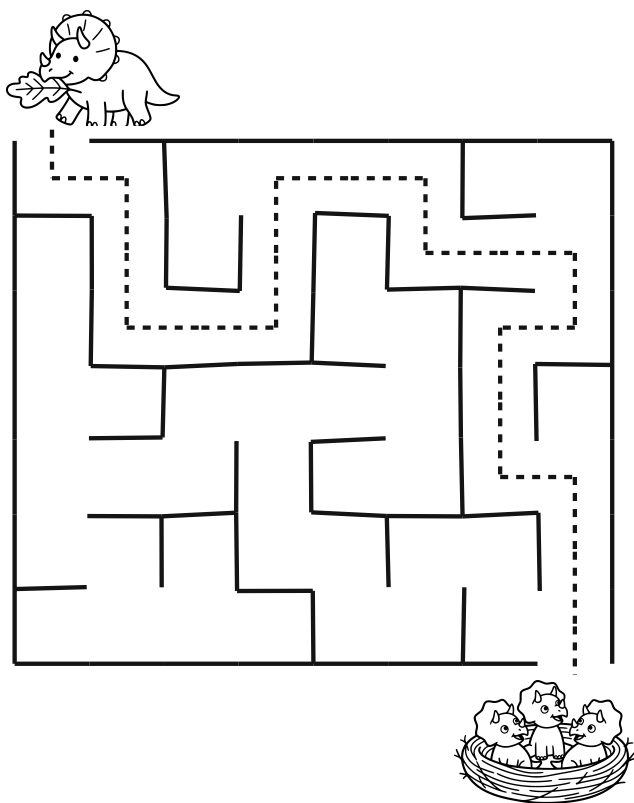
Tracks: T. rex → middle; Stegosaurus → bottom; Brachiosaurus → top.

Fossils: the three treasures are circled in the picture on the right.

Eggs: four eggs have spots.
